

TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION

1. EXHIBITOR COVENANTS

- a) The exhibitor agrees to abide by all rules and regulations adopted by The Health and Wellness Expos of Canada Inc. (herein after referred to as "Show Management") and its sponsors, and agrees that Show Management shall have the final decision in adopting any rule or regulation deemed necessary prior to, during, and after the show.
- b) The exhibitor agrees to observe all union contracts and labour relations agreements in force, agreements between Show Management and the official contractors serving the show facility, companies operating in the building in which the show is taking place, and to observe the labour laws of the jurisdiction in which the building is located. The exhibitor will not do anything directly or indirectly connected with their display which might be a violation of any laws, bylaws, ordinances, or regulations of any government or regulatory body.
- c) The exhibitor agrees to obtain, at its own expense, any **licenses or permits** which are required, including without limitation, from government bodies, or industry associations, and any other third parties, for the operation of its trade or business during the show, and to pay all taxes that may be levied against it as a result of the operation of its trade or business in their space allocated.
- d) The exhibitor agrees not to conduct or be associated with a promotional contest in connection with the show, where a prize or prizes having a value in excess of \$50 are offered, unless the exhibitor satisfies Show Management that the contest is being operated in accordance with local laws and regulations.
- e) The exhibitor, its officers, agents, employees and representatives, agree to obey any nonsmoking regulations in effect at the facility.
- f) The exhibitor will abide by all provincial and federal health restrictions put in place by the venue, province and Show Management to ensure safety of all.

2. DISPLAY

- a) The exhibitor agrees to occupy the contracted exhibit space during the full term of the show and to exhibit only the products described in this contract.
- b) Show Management reserves the right, in its sole and unfettered discretion to: (i) determine the eligibility of exhibitors and exhibits for the show, (ii) reject or prohibit exhibits or exhibitors which Show Management considers objectionable, (iii) relocate exhibitors or exhibits (iv) change venue or show dates when in the opinion of Show Management, such moves are necessary to maintain the character and/or good order of the show.
- c) The Exhibitor agrees to ensure that all display fixtures and materials are made of a fire retardant material as required by the fire department.
- d) The exhibitor agrees to maintain the placement of their exhibit and staff within the parameters of the display space provided in the agreement. Displays that extend outside of the approved parameters may be subject to enforcement by venue or governing bodies such as fire marshals.

3. ASSIGNMENT AND SUBLETTING

The exhibitor shall not assign any rights under this agreement or sublet the space without the prior written permission of Show Management, to which permission may be arbitrarily withheld. The Exhibitor shall not display products or services not listed on their application without prior arrangements.

4. INSURANCE - CERTIFICATE OF LIABILITY INSURANCE

As an exhibitor participating in a show, you must have adequate Liability Insurance with a minimum \$5,000,000 limit to protect the Exhibitors, the attending public, the show organizer, and yourself. Our insurance policy does not extend coverage to any exhibits and requires you to be responsible for attaining and providing your own Certificate of Insurance before arriving at the show. • If your company has an existing insurance policy, Contact your Insurance Company and request a Certificate of Insurance (COI) with the following requirements below: • Heath and Wellness Expos of Canada, 70 Macbell rd. Winnipeg, Mb R3V 1P3 listed as an additional insured. • List Show dates (includes all move-in, move-out days) • The policy shall provide coverage of at least \$5,000,000 for each separate occurrence. At the request of Show Management, the exhibitor shall provide Show Management with a copy of such policy.

6. EXHIBITOR'S PROPERTY

All of the exhibitor's property at the show shall be at the sole risk of the exhibitor and Show Management assumes no responsibility for loss or damage thereto.

7. BUILDING

- a) The exhibitor is liable for any damage they cause to the facility and to any property of Show Management, its agents, or any other exhibitor.
- b) The exhibitor may not apply paint, lacquer, adhesive, or other coatings to the facility or to the property of Show Management, its agents, or any other exhibitor.
- c) The exhibitor shall not apply tape or any other adhesive material to walls, ceilings, or any part of the venue without the express written approval consent of the venue management.

8. CONTRACT CANCELLATION AND TERMINATION

- a) This contract may only be cancelled by the exhibitor if notice in writing is received by Show Management at least ninety (90) days prior to the first day of the show. If an exhibitor cancels on or after these dates, the exhibitor is not eligible for any refund. This also includes contracts signed after the cancellation or 90 day deadline. Cancellation requests received or requested in writing prior to ninety (90) days before the show if approved, shall be levied a \$400.00 administration fee for cancellation.
- b) In the event the exhibitor fails to make payment as aforesaid or fails to comply in any respect with the terms of this contract, Show Management reserves the right to cancel this contract without notice and all rights of the exhibitor hereunder shall cease and terminate. Any payment made by the exhibitor on account hereof will be retained by Show Management as liquidated damages for breach of his contract and Show Management may there upon re-rent said space. Failure to appear at the event does not release the exhibitor from responsibility for payment of the full cost of the space rented.

9. REMOVAL OF EXHIBITS

The exhibitor agrees no display will be dismantled or goods removed during the entire run of the show, but will remain intact until the end of the final closing hour of the last show day. The exhibitor also agrees to remove its display and equipment from the show site by the final move out time limit, or in the event of failure to do so, the exhibitor agrees to pay for such additional cost as may be incurred by the venue.

10. CANCELLATION OR CURTAILMENT OF SHOW

In the event that the facility in which the show is being held, or scheduled to be held, is destroyed or becomes unavailable for occupancy, for reasons beyond the control of Show Management and its sponsors, or if for any reason Show Management is unable to permit the exhibitor to occupy the facility or the space, or if the show is cancelled or curtailed, Show Management and sponsors will not be responsible for any loss of business, loss of profits, damage, or expense of whatever nature that the exhibitor may suffer. The reasons listed include, but are not limited to, such reasons as: casualty, explosion, fire, lightning, flood, weather, pandemic, epidemic, earthquake, or other Acts of God, acts of public enemies, riots, civil disturbances, strikes, lockouts or boycotts.

11. EXCLUSIVITY OF PRODUCTS AND SERVICES

No Exhibitor will be guaranteed exclusivity of product or service. Show Management reserves the right to place their own limitations on the number of any type of company, product or service in the event. Our decision is final.

12. TICKET DISTRIBUTION

Any and all tickets obtained as part of the Show promotion are for pre-show promotion only. Distribution of tickets within the show venue is considered a breach of the booth rental agreement. Violators of this agreement may be asked to forfeit their position in the show immediately without recourse.

13. AGREEMENT

By completing and submitting the online or written application, you confirm that you have read, understand, and agree to these Terms & Conditions.

Submission of an application does not guarantee acceptance. Acceptance by Show Management, along with receipt of payment, constitutes a binding agreement between the exhibitor and Show Management. Booth space is not considered confirmed until the required deposit has been received.

Applications submitted without an appropriate deposit or without a signature may be refused by Show Management.
